Dear Secretary Bose:

Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County is notifying the Commission, per License Article 410 and related Fisheries and Habitat Monitoring Plan (Plan) Section 4.1 for the Jackson Hydroelectric Project, of its plans for monitoring activities in the Sultan River for the year 2018. The monitoring activities for 2018 will include:

- Riverine habitat monitoring per Plan Section 2.1, if there is a high flow event or other major event causing significant change. A significant change will be determined by a site-specific pedestrian survey, owing to a complete habitat survey being completed in 2016,
- Water temperature monitoring per Plan Section 2.2, and
- Spawner abundance, distribution and timing monitoring per Plan Section 3.1.
