Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County is notifying the Commission, per License Article 410 and related Fisheries and Habitat Monitoring Plan (Plan) Section 4.1 for the Jackson Hydroelectric Project, of its plans for monitoring activities in the Sultan River for the year 2021 under the subject License Article. The monitoring activities under License Article 410 for 2021 will include:

- Riverine habitat monitoring per Plan Section 2.1, if there is a high flow event or other major event causing significant change,
- Water temperature monitoring per Plan Section 2.2,
- Spawner abundance, distribution and timing monitoring per Plan Section 3.1.
- Juvenile production (smolt trap) monitoring per Plan Section 3.2.
