

- Under no circumstance shall the customer penetrate the wall of an existing energized vault with either conduit or conductor. Only Snohomish County PUD personnel and/or qualified PUD electrical contractors are authorized to penetrate into and/or access an existing energized vault.
- Snohomish County PUD and/or qualified PUD electrical contractors shall make all primary and secondary connections on PUD-owned transformers, secondary cabinets or secondary pedestals.
