Oil Spill Response and Remediation Summary 2021

In 2021, the PUD responded to 110 spill incidents involving a total of 584 gallons of transformer oil, 27 gallons of hydraulic oil, 7 gallons of capacitor fluid and 2 gallons of antifreeze. A total of approximately 140 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soils were removed, transported and disposed of at permitted disposal facilities. A summary of the spill types is listed below.
