PUD Commissioners Approve Rate Increase

In January, our Board of Commissioners approved a general rate increase for all residential and commercial electric and water customers.

- The Electric System budget includes a 2% general rate increase that will go into effect on April 1, 2023.
- The Water System budget includes a 2.75% rate increase that will go into effect on March 1, 2023.

Our board also approved a revised implementation of the base charge for electric customers, modifying the remaining deployment schedule from four years to two. The revised base charge schedule and rate increase will be implemented together, resulting in an average total increase on customers bills of approximately \$4 per month. We will begin installing new advanced meters through our Connect Up program later this year. These new meters are free of charge for customers and will give custom-

ers new tools to save energy and money. Among other benefits, advanced meters will minimize the need for estimated reads, enable real-time remote reconnect and disconnect for customers moving in or out, and decrease carbon emissions.
