

UNION JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: Apprentice Maintenance Mechanic

JOB DEFINITION:

Work with and under the direction of the Maintenance Foreman or Maintenance Mechanic in the performance of carpentry, mechanical, painting, low voltage electrical, sheet metal, piping, plumbing, installation and general maintenance necessary to construct and maintain buildings, operational equipment and tools, plant facilities and grounds.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

In addition, he will work with and under the direction of the Maintenance Foreman or Maintenance Mechanic in the repair and/or installation of low voltage electrical equipment, mechanical equipment and electro-mechanical equipment. On occasion, he may work independently on such projects as painting, ground maintenance, existing low voltage fixtures up to 120 volts, perform minor construction work, rearrange and move furniture, operate all equipment related to maintenance work, and clean by disassembling and reassembling such equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of:

· Basic building maintenance and equipment skills.

Ability to:

- Learn the maintenance mechanic skills; be familiar with tools, equipment, and materials used in maintenance work and perform general maintenance work on all types of plant facilities, grounds, operational equipment and tools
- Take study courses and other training, some of which would be taken on his own time, to help develop his skills.

License or Certification:

Valid Washington State Driver's License.
