

### **UNION JOB DESCRIPTION**

## TITLE: Maintenance Helper I/Support Services - Facilities

### **DEFINITION:**

Assists in the performance of maintenance tasks in all trades under the supervision of a Journeyman Maintenance Mechanic or Foreman.

## BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assists in moving furniture, materials, equipment or boxes.
- 2. Assists in general building maintenance such as cleaning equipment, replacing light bulbs, painting, and outfitting equipment.
- 3. Assists in measuring and layout of materials.
- 4. Performs other Maintenance duties as assigned.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

# Knowledge of:

Basic mathematics.

# Ability to:

- Use a tape measure and other measuring devices.
- Use tools and equipment of the trade.
- Understand and follow directions.
- Communicate effectively with co-workers.
- Demonstrate mechanical ability.
- Physically perform duties of job.

## Education/Experience:

· High school diploma or equivalent.

#### License/Certificates:

- Valid Washington State Driver's License.
- Successful completion of the Maintenance Helper exam.

## WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Duties are performed in a variety of environments both indoors and outdoors such as construction sites, building grounds, shop, or offices.
- The incumbent must have the ability to climb a ladder, lift and move approximately 65 pounds, and work in confined places such as ditches or ceiling panels.
