

UNION JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: Meter Foreman

DEFINITION:

Under the direction of the Metering Superintendent or his designee, works with and oversees the electrical metering activities of the Meter Shop employees.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:

This is a bid classification subject to CBA articles 6.2.5 and 6.2.7 where the District will select the successful candidate based on ability and personal qualifications.

BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assists the Metering Superintendent or designee in coordinating and delegating Meter Shop work activities. Serves as a Working Foreman with the ability to perform all duties of the Meter Shop.
- 2. Assists the Metering Superintendent or designee in coordinating Meter Shop training including, but not limited to, calibration, testing, maintenance and installation of all metering and related equipment.
- 3. Assists the Metering Superintendent or designee in maintaining a program for testing safety equipment. Investigate job related safety hazards. Works with the Metering Superintendent or designee to correct unsafe conditions.
- 4. Assists the Metering Superintendent or designee in investigating special projects for workability, safety, and equipment needs.
- 5. Assists the Metering Superintendent or designee in maintaining department records, maintaining adequate inventory, and making recommendations for equipment and personnel.
- 6. Maintains traceability of all District Standards to insure accurate calibration of all meters and equipment.
- 7. Assists the Metering Superintendent or designee in scheduling meter testing duties. Work with Meter Shop personnel on metering problems; develop solutions to possible difficulties.
- 8. Responds to electric metering questions and perform the duties of Special and Journeyman Metermen.
- 9. Ensures a safe and neat working area.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Performs other related duties as assigned.
- 2. Performs duties of lower level Meter classifications as necessary.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

These qualifications are those usually exhibited by a person with:

Knowledge of:

- District safety and WAC Electrical Workers Rules.
- First Aid and CPR methods.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: (continued)

Knowledge of: (continued)

- Electrical service requirements for metering.
- Complex metering installations.
- Training techniques.
- Customer Service techniques.
- Supervisory techniques.

Ability to:

- Coordinate and direct work of others.
- Analyze and resolve problems.
- Communicate and work effectively with all levels of the organization, other utilities and customers.
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Physically perform duties of the job.

Education/Experience:

- Five (5) years experience as a Journeyman Meterman.
- High School diploma or equivalent.

License, Certification and/or Testing:

- Successful completion of an interview process.
- Possess a valid Washington state driver's license.
- Possess a valid First Aid certificate.
- Possess a valid CPR certificate.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Work is generally performed in the Meter Shop and in the field and in all types of weather conditions.
- Exposed to hot electrical wires and equipment.
- Lift and carry up to 50 lbs.
- · Requires climbing ladders.
