Rate Increase Proposed to Address Rising Costs

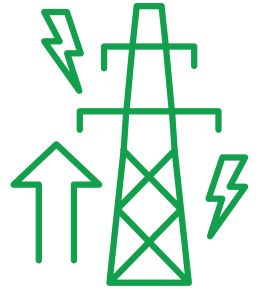
The PUD has proposed an increase of two percentage points to its original 3.8% revenue adjustment included in the 2024 electric budget following the recent cold weather event in early January.

If approved by the Commission, rates for PUD residential electric customers will increase from the current plan of 9.6 cents per kilowatt-hour to 10.3 cents. A typical residential customer's bill will increase by approximately \$6 per month.

For PUD small business customers, the

proposed rate increase will only affect their customer charge, resulting in an increase from 58 cents per day to 92 cents. All electric rate increases will take effect on April 1.

PUD water customers will see a rate increase of 5.4% on their bills this month. Part of the rate increase is due to a 2.4% pass-through rate increase from the City of Everett.
