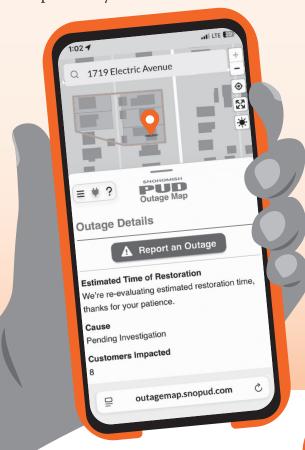

PUD Cuts Ribbon on New Side Channels

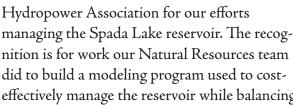
