Name of Proposal:

Electric Pathways for Transportation Grant Program

Description of Proposal:

Snohomish County PUD offers the Electric Pathways program under the Washington State Department of Ecology’s (Ecology) Clean Fuel Standard (CFS). The program aligns with the CFS’s aim to reduce greenhouse gas and conventional air pollutant emissions from transportation fuels used in Washington, while spurring economic development. Ecology provides program oversight to ensure that:

- All investments made with CFS residential EV charging credit revenues are spent on transportation electrification projects per RCW 70A.535.080.
- Investments are allocated into specific categories per RCW 70A.535.080.

The Electric Pathways for Transportation Grant Program is a non-project proposal that does not include specific locations or projects.
