**Name of Proposal:**

Electric Pathways for Transportation Grant Program

**Description of Proposal:**

Snohomish County PUD offers the Electric Pathways program under Washington State Department of Ecology's (Ecology) Clean Fuel Standard (CFS). The program aligned with the CFS aims to reduce greenhouse gas and conventional air pollutant emissions from transportation fuels used in Washington while spurring economic development. Ecology provides program oversight to ensure that:

- All investments made with CFS residential EV charging credit revenues are spent on transportation electrification projects per RCW 70A.535.080.
- Investments are allocated into specific categories per RCW 70A.535.080.

Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County

**Location of Proposal:**

The Electric Pathways for Transportation Grant Program is a non-project proposal that does not include specific locations or projects.

**Lead Agency:**

Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County
